3 DAY TOURNAMENT (F) (I,A) \$100 (pay Treasurer in advance) Register by July 10th

July 16-18 - Founders Cup - Association, Doubles, 2 hr. games, Team sign up or Individual sign up and partner will be assigned by Director R. McCrea. Maximum 12 teams. Fee includes Friday night reception for players. (Add \$15 for spouses), morning coffee, daily refreshments and lunch Friday & Saturday for players.

2021 TOURNAMENT SCHEDULE

Players may register by contacting the Tournament Director (email) or registering at the BICC.ca Event Calendar

Block Play is multi-week 'league' play in different formats. The # of blocks (usually 1-3) and # of games (usually 2-5) per round depends on the number of players that register. Signing up for block play is a commitment to play the first round between **June 1st and July 11th** *and* the second round between **July 19th and August 25th**.

All players play in the first round and then are sorted into Championship and "A" flights, based on each player's win-loss record, for the second round. Semi-finals are held for Association blocks on **August 28-29**. Finals for all blocks are held on **September 4-5**. The schedule for semi-finals and finals is subject to change.

If there are ties in win/loss record, head to head results count, then net hoops.

Games are arranged between the players. Either player can initiate a request for games but ultimately it is the responsibility of the player listed on the top row of the draw to ensure games are arranged. Scores are kept by players on sheets posted in the Clubhouse.
